GREED

DESTROYER OF MAN

The Sun shines constantly. The Earth turns regularly, permitting all of its sides to have light.

Heat from the Sun expands the water from oceans and lakes, creating a lesser density which ascends to cooler altitudes and condenses into water again.

Heat from the Sun also expands the air at the crust of the earth, creating a lesser density which ascends and causes air currents. These air currents transport the water from oceans and lakes to farms.

The mixture of ingredients from the water, the soil, the sun and escaping gases from the interior of the earth creates vegetation.

Man had nothing to do with making the Sun, the Earth or Water. He has nothing to do with turning the Earth around. He does not form the air currents that transport water from oceans and lakes to farms. He does not mix the ingredients of water, soil, gases and sun that cause vegetation. Since having charge of this human form, it has been my privilege to delve deep into the causes and effects of Natural Laws and after all my efforts for true information, I have never been able to find one flaw in God's work. I have found a good reason for everything that He has done.

It has also been my duty during this material life to study man-made laws to a very large extent, and I must say that I have found them to be most imperfect, impractical, idiotic and debasing.

Bad laws have made bad men whose antics I have found to be not only ludicrous but vicious and demoralizing.

During my whole life I have found men fighting each other; cheating each other; lying to each other; stealing from each other; starving each other; torturing each other; stabbing each other; shooting each other; murdering each other, and doing everything else that is degrading and horrible. The foolish ones call these monstrous actions "human nature," which they insist cannot be changed.

Such a state of affairs merely arises from bad man-made laws and an impractical economic system.

A system that breeds such debasing human conditions is positively unacceptable to God, and the time has now come when man must change it or sink to the level of wild beasts.

Ever since I can remember, workmen have fought workmen; farmers have fought farmers; professionals have fought professionals; merchants have fought merchants; manufacturers have fought manufacturers; bankers have fought bankers, and financiers have fought financiers.

What have they gained after all these years of ungodly and un-economic strife? NOTHING.

The workmen have lost their jobs; the farmers have lost their farms; the professionals have lost their patrons, the merchants have lost their stores; the manufacturers have lost their factories; the bankers have lost their banks, and the financiers have lost their souls.

Yes, even the bloated financiers have paid a horrible penalty for their sins; particularly the atrocious sins whereby they starve helpless infants and rob feeble old folks of their belongings. During the past few years more than five thousand money-mad financiers have been forced to commit suicide by the infernal interest collecting system which they have operated.

Therefore, it is the vicious man-made interest collecting system that has debased and is now de-

stroying all semblance of honesty and decency in the human race. It is this wretched system which the people uphold that breeds suicides, murderers, thieves and swindlers. It is man's greed that is the cause of it all.

The whole debasing interest collecting practice is based upon an unnatural desire to get something for nothing. Such a practice is contrary to Natural Law which recognizes effort as the basis of productivity.

That which is obtained without effort is weakening and degrading.

The interest collecting system is a weakening and degrading game, a treacherous game that leads people to believe they can get something for nothing, but, before the game is over, they discover they have lost everything they had, even their souls.

The interest collecting game is run by slickers who promise the people everything but give them nothing. They tell the people that if they lend their money at six per cent interest they will be the gainers. The foolish people think they are going to get something for nothing and join in the game.

But, while giving the people six per cent interest as their share, the slickers take, by various slippery credit methods, two hundred per cent interest as their share. So the people, being unable to pay the two hundred per cent interest, caused by compounded credits, are forced to give back their six per cent interest to the slickers, and all of their property as well.

So, because of the people's greed and desire to get something for nothing, they become easy victims for the tricky financiers, and as long as the people take part in such a crooked game they must not only put up with the consequences, but, before God, they are responsible for all of their own misery and suffering as well as the suffering they have caused others. Especially the suffering they have caused the weak little babies and the feeble old folks.

One thing the people must understand and that is that these horrible conditions are caused by themselves and are not the fault

of their Maker. God does his work perfectly, but the people do their work foolishly.

To starve their babies when there are enough cows to furnish plenty of milk for all of them; to starve feeble old folks when God has furnished enough food for everybody; to close their factories when millions of men want work and everybody needs the products, proves that the people are not only foolish, but have put in charge of their affairs impractical persons without knowledge of the elementary principles of management or economics.

Unless the people arouse themselves soon to the danger of their position and put a stop to this interest collecting swindle, they are doomed to descend to a race of paupers, slaves, cut throats and lunatics.

Think of this: the people of the United States owe to the financiers, either privately or through their Federal, State, County and Municipal Governments, more than Three Hundred Billion Dollars. That means that at exorbitant interest they must pay Twenty Billion Dollars a year in interest. There is not enough money in the United States to pay the interest alone, not saying anything about the principal. And the principal itself is nothing more than back interest.

So the interest, according to this game, must compound until there will not be enough wealth in the country to pay the indebtedness.

Financiers have been allowed to build an upside down pyramid with this ever growing interest collection from a Five Billion Dollar Gold Base (before revaluation). Particularly base. They having control of the money, charge interest upon credit, and then they charge interest upon the interest that they have charged upon the credit. So the indebtedness is always multiplying itself.
