MANEUVERABILITY

(MAN-OO-VER-A-BIL-I-TY)

Eternal SPACE is ruled by NATURAL LAWS that always were, are now and always will be the same.

NATURAL LAWS will never change.

It is the physical formations throughout space that are forever changing from one composition to another, not the Laws, as is so clearly explained in LAWSONOMY.

The author of that advanced work spent his whole life gaining knowledge of NATURAL LAWS and explaining them so that even children can understand them if their minds are kept free from dope and they are permitted to exercise their mental functions naturally.

Alfred Lawson did not spend his life to acquire such knowledge to sell it for money; he did it to help human beings rise to a higher state of intelligence and to shield them from the pestilence of ignorance. He does this work as a DUTY, not for pay.

There is a mighty gulf between the Laws that Alfred Lawson teaches under the name of LAWSONOMY and man-made rules that are taught in the colleges as social procedure

Lawson's teachings only relate to the things that are real and provable. That which cannot be proved is not LAWSONOMY.

Natural Laws are constant. That which is true can be verified over and over again and again forever according to their formulas.

Most of the stuff they teach in colleges is ancient hearsay from which they offer no positive proof. They hold guessing bees in those institutions in which the Professors and students waste their time arguing over silly theories.

The poor devils remind us of the ancient Chinese philosophers who professed that none could be scholars who did not wear pigtailed and long finger nails.

Yes, many of these collegians go mad and some of them froth at the mouth when one tries to enlighten them with provable laws, or undertakes to show them how human conditions can be improved upon.

Still, whether they like it or not they must be propped along until they get onto the right track. Why let them waste their time like bickering simpletons when for the same expenditure of mental effort they could absorb Lawson's magnified knowledge and

prove themselves useful to God and man.

There is nothing in TRUTH to argue about.

FALSITY causes discordant altercations that leads to hate and insanity. It is the fraudulent system of tribute that causes universal greed and degradation.

Truth is knowledge — falsity is ignorance.

The people must be fed upon truth, not falsity, if the human race is to develop itself.

Truth is provable by Natural Laws.

Take HEAT, for instance:

The same temperature will act the same under certain conditions at any time or place. The same quantity of heat will dissolve the same quantity of matter in the same way today, tomorrow or a million years from now.

It would make no difference whether you, or I, or someone else, would jump into a fiery furnace, any or all of our bodies would be quickly expanded by the heat and pass away in particles to be used over and over again and again perpetually in the make-up of other formations.

Then again, take COLD; the opposite of HEAT:

At a certain temperature COLD would freeze the bodies of you or I, or any one else, and make them unusable any longer, except as materials to be used over and over again eternally to feed other bodies.

It would certainly be a whopper undertaking to attempt to put together again a human carcass after it had been disintegrated and its particles had flown away to join other bodies, notwithstanding the professor's pet theory that such a scaplication will some day be accomplished.

Now, let us make a brief examination of such a grotesque theory.

Assuming, for instance, that one of these pretentious professors had been parboiled by heat and lay in some out of the way place that was infested by vultures whose natural work is to absorb dead bodies that have no other means of burial:

The dead body of that professor would then become a part of a live vulture, wouldn't it?

Then, assuming that the vulture after assimilating the professor should be devoured by some hungry wolf, would not the professor then become part of the

wolf as well as part of the vulture?

Would not those same materials feed the wolf that had fed the vulture and had previously fed the man?

Now, assuming that the same materials of which the professor was composed passes along from one creature to another for a few thousand years, what sort of a multiformed beast do you suppose he would look like when resurrected, as we are told will eventually happen to these professors.

Of course, according to Natural Law the physical body of the much devoured professor will never be pieced together again, but the materials of which he was composed will be used over and over again eternally for the life giving qualities of other things of various shapes and kinds.

During the year of 1873, while Alfred Lawson was at the age of 4 years and was living at the corner of Beaubien and Division streets, Detroit, Michigan, he was attacked with a slight case of measles and was kept within a darkened room.

On that occasion he noticed that streaks of sunlight passed between the blinds and window frames which illuminated the dust that floated in the air.

So while studying the movements of those flying particles he pictured in his mind that they were a series of minute worlds moving about in space.

By blowing out his breath against those particles he learned that he could push them away and scatter them apart by PRESSURE and that by drawing in his breath he could pull them in and hold them together by SUCTION.

That was the beginning of Alfred Lawson's study of Natural Laws.

So, from the year of 1873 he followed his own line of natural analysis until he discovered the basic law of movement and was able to explain his findings in such language that other human beings could understand and then utilize such knowledge for their own progressive development.

Having mastered the principle of perpetual movement he called this great law PENETRABILITY and made known its formula showing how all matter is used over and over again forever without the loss of a particle.

PENETRABILITY, therefore, is the basic law of movement and

is the most far reaching discovery ever made by man.

Knowing the method by which the Omnipotent operates the movement of matter everywhere in SPACE and by which He utilizes everything without the loss of anything, Alfred Lawson was enabled to unravel many other natural problems hitherto unknown to man which necessitated the production of such books as PENETRABILITY, CREATION, MANLIFE, LAWSONOMY, MENTALITY and THE ALMIGHTY that gives unto mankind a higher education than ever known before and an opportunity to advance in genuine scholarship leading towards the development of an advanced species upon Earth.

As knowledge enters the brain cells ignorance is forced out of the drain pores.

During his life's contemplation of physical laws, Alfred Lawson also discovered a great Spiritual Law which he called MANEUVERABILITY.

This marvelous law regulates the action between one's body and one's soul.

It is a very ignorant professor who thinks that a physical machine makes and operates itself.

It is a very ignorant professor who thinks that because a physical machine must be destroyed that its Creator and operator must be destroyed also.

All one has to do is to study the airplane, automobile, steam boat or electric locomotive to prove that such is not the case.

The body of a man is a machine with which he gets around from place to place and uses in the performance of his natural duties.

One's soul is the guide of one's body. The soul is spiritual and the body is physical.

It is just as necessary that man's physical machine must have a guide as it is for the airplane, automobile, steam boat or electric locomotive to have a guide.

So it is a very ignorant person who thinks that because his body must die that his soul also must die.

In his book, MENTALITY, Alfred Lawson explains how the constructive Menorgs put into microscopic seed the entire plan of a physical creature before it is born and then through the expanding and contracting process of SUCTION and PRESSURE how the machine is built up to its natural proportions.

In his book, BORN AGAIN, Alfred Lawson explains how the soul enters and departs from the physical body.

Now, his Law of MANEUVERABILITY explains how the soul, which is the guide for the body, is rewarded or punished, both here and hereafter, for the right or wrong management of the physical machine that has been entrusted to its care.

Yes, your soul, which is YOU, has been entrusted with a human machine by your Creator for a certain specific purpose.

A human machine is of a higher physical grade than that of a vulture and the Creator, therefore, expects YOU to do a higher grade of work than that of a vulture.

Eating dead animals, so that everything will be utilized without the loss of anything, according to natural economics, is the specific duty of the vulture, but such a beastly performance is not the specific duty of a human being.

So when YOU feed your human machine with the dead flesh of other animals YOU are merely doing the work the Creator expects of the lower grade vulture, but not the work HE expects to be done by the higher grade human being.

Therefore, by so doing, YOU have degraded and made inferior the human machine the CREATOR entrusted you with. That is wrong and everybody who follows this filthy practice is punished with inferior bodies that are subject to all sorts of physical ailments.

If you lent someone an automobile and he put whiskey in the gas tank and tobacco juice in the oil pockets and finally set fire to the machine, would you lend him another one to destroy the second time?

You would say, "Never again, for such a lunatic."

Well, what do you think the Creator would say after having lent to YOU a two-legged automobile and you put whiskey into its gas tank and cigarette poison into its oil pockets and finally blew its head off with fire arms?

No doubt HE would say, "Never again will I lend such a lunatic another such machine."

Now, according to LAWSONOMY, as soon as one physical machine is worn out the soul is furnished with another physical machine with which to carry on fur-

ther work in connection with nature's general plans.

So, acting and re-acting strictly according to Natural Law, if you fail to treat right the human machine that your Creator has loaned to you, and use its mental instruments for the great work of improving yourself and unselfishly helping to develop the whole human race to a higher state of intelligence, then it is a certainty that HE will not lend you a better physical machine to destroy the next time, but will positively demote you to a lower grade creature with inferior physical machinery as your present conduct proves that YOU deserve.

You should realize that you cannot fool the ALMIGHTY nor bribe HIM to change the laws to meet your favor no matter how much you may try to flatter HIM or whine about your bad reactions.

If you do what is right, the Law of MANEUVERABILITY will work for you, but if you do what is wrong, the Law of MANEUVERABILITY will work against you.

Man is made up of physical, mental and spiritual parts.

His physical machinery is operated by the constructive menorgs that inhabit every cell of his mental system and come under the general direction of the mind.

These microscopic builders are capable of communicating tele-mentally with the menorgs of other physical bodies.

The mind of man is guided by the advice of his soul which is a spiritual unit of the all pervading essence of God.

The conscience is the reflector of the soul which brings to the mind the Creator's messages of right thinking.

The mind controls the conscious activities of the physical body.

Now, as the Creator is always right, and demonstrates what is right through HIS immutable laws, then if man will strictly obey those laws he will be doing what is right and nothing harmful can happen to him.

But, if man will not obey these immutable laws, then, by breaking them, he will be doing wrong and will have to pay a penalty accordingly.

To quote passages from the third book of LAWSONOMY (THE ALMIGHTY):

"According to GOD, right is always right and wrong is always wrong.

"Thus right can never be wrong and wrong can never be right.

"There is a law that protects right and punishes wrong and whosoever breaks that law loses GOD'S protection and suffers consequences equal to the offense committed.

"The Law of MANEUVERABILITY will always protect one who does what is right and always punish one who does what is wrong.

"This is accomplished through spiritual guidance of those who do right into paths that lead away from danger and by driving those who do wrong into the paths that lead to punishment.

"There is no way for the wrongdoer to escape the punishment deserved. It is as certain as the wrong that has already been done.

"It is as certain as bad reaction follows bad action.

"Every act causes a react—even unto eternity.

"Good action leads to good reaction; bad action leads to bad reaction.

"Like begets like; those who kill are killed; those who hate are hated; those who cheat are cheated; those who rob are robbed; those who mistreat are mistreated; those who degrade are degraded; those who destroy are destroyed; and, those who love are loved; those who give are given; those who inspire are inspired.

"Action and reaction are everywhere and everybody must abide by their results. So whether it is a reward for a good act or a penalty for a bad act none can escape it.

"God gave to man, through His builders, the Menorgs, a physical machine by which he could move himself from place to place by his

own initiated power. That machine also acts as his earthly home.

"God also gave to man, billions of live servants, the menorgs, to operate this physical machine.

"These menorgs, the builders and operators of man, work day and night to keep man in good repair so that he may always be in good condition to perform his natural duties to God to whom he owes the gift of intelligence.

"This God-given machine, the earthly home of man, also contains a marvelous mental system through which these billions of menorgs can communicate with one another at all times in reference to the work of keeping man alive.

"To keep man alive and properly operate this machine these menorgs require raw materials with which they generate heat and power for that purpose.

"These raw materials come from the outside of man and are furnished by God in the shape of vegetable matter developed through the mixture of earthly gases and sun rays.

"This vegetable matter is furnished so abundantly by the Creator that hundreds of billions of human creatures could be nourished on earth for millions of years to come if they will work according to God's Natural Laws instead of working against His Laws as they have been doing for thousands of years past.

"There is a right way and a wrong way to utilize vegetable matter for the creation of heat and power within man.

"If man will utilize vegetable matter the right way then his physical machinery and mental system will work right. But if he will not utilize this vegetable matter the right way then his physical machinery and mental system will work wrong.

"Man's whole physical being, therefore, works strictly according to action and reaction.

"Now, spiritual action and reaction are graded in man, either for or against him, as he himself thinks.

"Good thoughts bring good reaction and bad thoughts bring bad reaction. As you give so will you receive.

"What you would like to happen to others will sooner or later happen to you.

"The Law of MANEUVERABILITY will work to protect you if you deserve it, or it will work to punish you if you deserve it.

"Whichever way you turn will be the right way, for your protection, if you have no evil thoughts concerning other creatures, or whichever way you turn will be the wrong way if you wish evil things would happen to others.

"God's reactions are for or against you spiritually as well as physically in strict accordance with your own actions.

"There is no escape from God's Law of MANEUVERABILITY.

"You go to a higher or lower state of existence after this life in accordance with your actions while here.

"Whatever harm you have done to others of lesser strength in this life, so others of greater strength will do to you in your next life."

Nothing happens according to chance. Everything happens according to Law. It is action and reaction according to the Law of right or wrong. One may pay the penalty in this life for the wrong one did in the last life or receive their reward in this life for doing what was right in the last life.

One who has been given the opportunity to develop himself and do right according to the Laws promulgated in LAWSONOMY and still continues to do wrong, will receive worse punishment than if he had never been made acquainted with such information.

To refuse knowledge is worse than if one had never been given the opportunity to receive it.

To try and tear down the TRUTHS of LAWSONOMY is as if one would try to tear down the works of the Creator or stop the workings of HIS Natural Laws.

PROGRAM AND MONEY SYSTEM

In Vol. 1, No. 26, BENEFACTOR, Alfred Lawson outlined TEN BASIC PRINCIPLES to insure freedom for the people of the U.S.A., as follows:

(1) Abolish Interest. (2) Capitalism without Financialism. (3) Congressional Control of Money and Credit. (4) Utilization of the Lawson Money System. (5) Direct Credits for Everybody. (6) The American Form of Government. (7) No Foreign Interference in the U.S.A. (8) Freedom of Spiritual Worship. (9) General Freedom of Expression. (10) Compulsory Arbitration.

Principle 3 states that the Constitution of the United States gives to Congress the power to coin money and regulate the value thereof.

But private financiers have usurped that power and now they profess an inalienable right to print and curtail the use of money to suit themselves.

Therefore, INTEREST must be ABOLISHED and Congress authorize the adoption of the LAWSON MONEY SYSTEM, as copyrighted in the book "KNOW BUSINESS."

The eleven points of the LAWSON MONEY SYSTEM are as follows:

FIRST—this money system will be owned, controlled and operated by the people themselves under the management of their trustee—the government.

SECOND—money will have no value at all but will merely act as a measure for the value of land, products or labor.

THIRD—the money will be loaned to the people by the government, acting as trustee, without any charges for its use whatsoever.

FOURTH—the government will have the power to recall the money instead of having to redeem it.

FIFTH—as money will have no value in this system the quantity of it issued will not effect its purchasing power.

SIXTH—as the quantity issued will not effect its purchasing power, money, according to the Lawson system, cannot be inflated or deflated. It cannot be stretched or shrunk in the measurement of value any more than a yard can be stretched or shrunk in the measurement of distance.

SEVENTH—money under this plan will be made to spend and not to hoard or sell.

EIGHTH—to prevent hoarding of money the government will recall it at specified times and exchange new money for it. The old money will then become worthless and have no purchasing power.

NINTH—a supply of ready money will be kept on hand at all times by the government in sufficient quantities to meet all trade requirements so that industry cannot be held up for the want of it under any circumstances.

TENTH—paper money will be used most extensively as the trade convenience, although copper, nickel and silver will be used for small coinage. Paper money is most convenient for handling purposes as well as being the least expensive and quickest to make.

ELEVENTH—as security for its money the people will pledge the entire wealth of their country, which will give it a backing equal to its utilization."

EDITORIAL

This Editorial, published in the March, 1909, issue of FLY, was one of the many stimulating forecasts written by Alfred W. Lawson for his magazines FLY and AIR-CRAFT that attracted general attention to the future possibilities of the Aircraft Industry and Airline Service during the first days of Aviation. It was addressed to a King who had the social power to do something extraordinary but not sufficient mental power to foresee the opportunity.

ALPHONSO, King of Spain, greeting:

We heard you were dead—or at least that Spain was dead, which is about the same thing—but now we are informed that not only are you alive, but that you are a leader among leaders. We have been told that you are interested in flying machines, and if this is a fact, then there can be no doubt that you are alive in every sense of the word.

Alfonso, you are young. There is still sufficient elasticity to your brain to form impressions of things that have as yet not come to pass; to allow your mind to draw pictures of the wonderful future in store for the human race; to look forward to extraordinary events that are to come instead of being satisfied with the ordinary affairs of the present or the monkey records of the past.

Barring accidents and providing you exercise your physical and mental functions correctly, the next forty years will be the most important part of your life. During that time you can chisel your name in history so deep that it will take thousands of years to efface it, if you only go about it in the right way.

To begin with, you must forget the past as quickly as possible. Bury it, only glance at it upon rare occasions. There is very little to enthuse over in looking backward. At best our ancestors were ignorant, selfish, vain glorious, vicious savages, and the sooner we can get away from the idiotic notions we inherited from them the better.

Next you must look around and ascertain what improvements are needed here on earth that will benefit mankind—not only the Spaniard, but every living human being, be he black, white, red, yellow or brown.

No man can be classed as great who considers only the needs of himself or his own family and permits his neighbor to rot either physically or mentally for the want of his assistance. A nation is nothing more or less than an enlarged family. So allow your mind to expand sufficiently to enable you to understand that every human being is constructed by the same creative force that brought you into existence, and try and treat them as you would like to be treated yourself if nature had not been so kind to you.

Having reached this stage of mental development you will then be anxious to live for others as well as for yourself, and will look about to see what you can do for the common good.

In order to aid humanity in a substantial and lasting way you must use your foresight and look into the future. Looking into the past will do no good. Nature set your eyes in front of the head for the purpose of looking forward, and if you wish to accomplish anything worth recording during your short stay upon earth, you must keep them fixed in that direction.

If you look straight ahead you cannot fail to see that flight through space by mechanical means is the very next step in human progress. That man has reached the stage where he is capable of getting off the earth. At first the distance he will be able to put between himself and the earth will be but a few feet and the time but a few hours, but as years go by he will gradually increase both distance and time until he will be able to go off into space on exploration tours for months and even years duration just as Columbus did about four hundred years ago on a lower scale.

You know what made Isabella the most famous Queen in history. There is nothing to prevent you from being the most famous King of all time if you will only look in the right direction. Straight ahead.

Study the subject of aerial flight and the sooner you begin the better. While the aerial thought is only tickling the skull of most people you allow it to take root and grow in your brain. Think of it, talk of it, dream of it and compel all of your brightest young men to do likewise. Invite all of the great inventors of aerial craft in the world to visit you and build great factories for construction purposes. Have your best editors write much upon the subject and your school teachers impress it upon the minds of the children. In this way you will stimulate the imagination of the rising generation and within twenty years one of your subjects (or perhaps an American who can get no recognition at home) may come to you with a plan to sail away to the moon or Mars, and while the rest of the world in a childish way think it is IMPOSSIBLE, just as the puny minds thought it was IMPOSSIBLE to cross the Atlantic four hundred years ago, you will be in a position to emulate the example of the illustrious Isabella and win for yourself everlasting glory.
