One progressive mind that financial swindlers had gotten beings to be guided by and are cers the tricks of the slickers and who are seeking truth instead of falsity.

The power to think is governed by the mind.

The mind is that part of the mental system having authority to decide the movements of the body.

The mental system is the machinery in living forms through which feeling and consciousness are manifested. In man it consists of mental fibers, mental channels, mental currents, spinal cord and brain.

The mental fibers are small tubes through which currents of mentality pass, carrying messages to and from the senses and the center of consciousness of living forms.

Mentality is a substance of subtle, penetrating quality and great speed of movement. It is used to manifest feeling or consciousness through the instrumentality of the mental system.

The mind is developed and strengthened through the exercise of its various functions just as the muscular system is developed and strengthened by the exercise of its various functions.

To quote from my book, MEN-TALITY: "Constant exercising of the mental functions in constructiveness creates expansion of those organs which develops greater efficiency for absorbing it.

"The chief governing functions of the mental system are located in the brain which is a mass of cells and tissue that almost fills the cavity inside of the skull. It has three parts-cerebrum, cerebellum and medula oblongataeach of which has separate governing functions

"The weight of the brain of an adult will average about three pounds. Its weight and size is increased by concentrated thinking. It obtains its fuel for power from substances brought to it by the blood.

"The brain is made of two kinds of materials - gray matter composed largely of cells that are operated by the menorgs and white matter consisting principally of fibers through which the currents of mentality pass to all parts of the body.

"The cerebrum, in which the mind is located, is in the topmost and largest part of the brain. It is covered with deep furrows Such leaders must be developed and convolutions and is divided into two parts by a groove extending from front to rear. of the body and the left half PENETRABILITY controls the right side of the body.

"The cerebellum, in which the muscle control is centered, lies at the back of the nead beneath the cerebrum.

"The medula oblongata is situated between the main brain and spinal cord. It is about one and a quarter inches in length and controls the heart action, breathing, swallowing and the expansion and contraction of the blood vessels of the vaso-motor system. "Connecting with the medula

oblongata and running downward inside of the spinal column is a circular cord about a half-inch in diameter known as the spinal cord which terminates at the lower end of the backbone.

"There are two mental channels-sensory and motory.

"The sensory channel carries from all parts of the body to the mental centers and brain the impressions felt by the skin, tongue, nostrils, eyes and ears.

"The motory channel conveys the orders issued from the brain through the mental centers to the different muscles of the body.

"One channel is used by the brain for receiving messages and the other channel is used by the brain for sending messages.

"Each channel from the spinal cord starts from the cells in the center of the cord and passes between the vertebrae and outward to the different parts of the body connecting with the brain. Each of these channels comes from the cord in the two branches known as roots.

"The anterior root conveys orders from the brain to the muscles and the posterior root carries the impressions from the skin and other organs to the spinal cord and brain.

"When the two branches combine, they form a mental trunk which is made up into a bundle of innumerable mental fibers by which means every menorg operating the mental instruments of every cell in every muscle or every part of the skin receives from and sends to the brain messages. The substance mentality is used in the transmission of these mental messages according to the same principles that the substance sound is used in the transmission of oracular messages.

"Thinking causes consciousness

"Consciousness is a state of knowing what happens.

"Man's consciousness is the reaction of intelligence drawn from external sources through the channel of his senses. A broader consciousness will create a superior man.

"To obtain a broader consciousness, however, man must develop greater mental instruments within himself with which to harness mentality in larger quan-

"To increase the power of his mental instruments, man must give them strenuous use.

"Intellectual effort will increase the capacity of the mental instruments, permitting them to consume large quantities of mentality and thereby broaden man's consciousness by which he will obtain a greater perspective of

"Man, now in his kindergarten stage, has been developed so far through the use of his five primitive senses.

"These senses have been attuned to the chemical conditions that surround the earth. His sense of sight has been developed by sunlight; his sense of taste by liquids; his sense of smell by gases; his sense of hearing by sound: and his sease of feeling

by pressure.

"But as man expands his consciousness his mind will become more inquisitive concerning Natural Law and he will thereby gain an insight into such wonders of nature that he never dreamed of before.

"The brain of man is composed of billions of cells containing mental instruments that are operated by menorgs. The power to operate these mental instruments is produced by suction and pressure according to the law of sity.

"The menorgs obtain their external impressions through the operation of the senses.

"If these external impressions coming through the senses are accurate and true representations of what happens outside of the body the menorgs gain knowledge that creates efficiency.

"But if these external impressions coming through the senses are inaccurate or false representations of what happens on the outside of the body then lacking knowledge their efficiency is lessened or becomes void.

"In proportion to the quantity of false impressions they receive, the mental development of the menorgs is retarded, and, operating their mental instruments with misrepresentations causes inferior and erratic thinking.

"So instead of constructing mental instruments for the cells that should convey genuine information to the mind of what happens in the outside world the adulterated stuff coming to them through the senses causes the construction of faulty machinery that

"A great future is in store for man if he will develop the necessary mental strength through cooperation to be able to grasp it.

"The Creator is ever willing to guide man but He will not do his work for him. Man must use his own efforts for self development.

"But just now man is a very sick creature mentally caused by the piggishness of individuals.

"Such mental sickness cannot be cured by piggish maniacs. It must be cured by unselfish people. "The time is now ripe for the

### THE SCIENTIST AND HIS RULE

In THIS INCOMPREHENSIBLE STATE called nature, scientists are necessary JUST AS EVERYTHING ELSE THAT IS, is necessary. But as all things excepting time and space have limitations, so have the scientists. They are NOT infallible. In fact, they are more often wrong than right. It seems strange, but it is a fact, nevertheless, that most scientific men are very narrow in their views of things they do not understand. They will make no allowance for anything that will not work according to rule—they are sticklers for rule and if a problem cannot be solved according to their methods, then it cannot be solved at all.

One of the first scientists on earth was the savage who first learned to count. He began in a simple way by using his fingers and thumbs as examples. As he had but ten digits on his two hands, ten was the limit of his calculations. At this stage HE REACHED THE END OF HIS RULE AND COULD GO NO FURTHER. In fact, to him there was no further to go. So he publicly proclaimed that forever afterward ten would be the numerical limit. Anything beyond that point was IMPOSSIBLE.

But later a younger and more advanced scientist came along and demonstrated that it WAS POSSIBLE to go beyond ten and that by utilizing the toes as well as the fingers and thumbs for examples the stupendous figure of twenty could be reached. This number, however, according to the second scientist, would positively be the limit in counting during all eternity. HE, TOO, HAD ARRIVED AT THE END OF HIS RULE.

And just so with hundreds of thousands of other scientists who have come and gone since, they added a little to human knowledge and upon reaching the end of their rules were most dogmatic in their belief that progress was to stop right then and there.

All through history there are innumerable instances in which scientists actually retarded human progress as well as aided it. In fact, almost every new idea born in the brain of man is first ridiculed and declared impossible by scientists who cannot figure it out according to rule.

We all know what a hard time Captain Erecson had trying to convince scientists that the little screw wheel in the stern of a large ocean steamship would propel it. Such a thing was contrary to all

known scientific rules up to that time.

And it was not until almost every school boy in the United States could throw a ball so that it would curve in the air that scientists would believe that it was anything more than an optical illusion.

So when Nikola Tesla, the eminent scientist, recently declared that "It will never be possible to go beyond certain rather narrow limits in aerial performance," we could not help thinking that NI-KOLA HAD ABOUT REACHED THE END OF HIS RULE

Man's greatest achievements are yet to be accomplished, and—mark the prediction—this is to happen OFF OF THE EARTH, NOT ON IT. He has but just started to acquire knowledge pertaining to natural laws, but, like the youngster fresh from college, he imagines he knows a great deal. He has been so preoccupied admiring himself during the past that he has a sort of fixed notion in his mind that the earth is the center of the universe, so he keeps his nose pointed toward the ground and sticks close to his little back yard. The idea that it is possible for him to construct machines where-

by he could go off into space and explore the heavens is altogether too big a thought to crowd into his little head, and besides, he has

no rules for such tremendous undertakings.

When man gets out of the economic rut he is in at present and When man gets out of the economic rut he is in at present and becomes more unselfish and thinks less of his own stomach than he does now, he will devote much time to the study of universal laws, and to do this successfully, he will have TO GET OFF THE EARTH. This can be accomplished by mechanical flight. A few steps have been taken along this line—there are millions of steps yet to follow.

Each stride forward will bring up new problems to be solved and new rules to be understood and old ones to be discarded. No obstacle will be too great to be overcome on his everlasting march

forward. The little toy mechanical device which he now calls a flying machine, will do its work in the forward movement, but to try and compare the future of mechanical flight by this little plaything is like comparing our higher mathematics to the system inaugurated by the first scientist, who counted by his toes.
